## Dining Information

The cuisine you will enjoy on your APT 4WD adventure goes above and beyond the standard meals you would expect on coach tours anywhere in the world. In fact, many dining events will be memorable holiday experiences. We pay careful attention to the negotiation of our menus to ensure choice and a healthy variety of quality food that caters to all tastes. Meals that are included in your tour price are clearly indicated on your itinerary.

**Dietary Requests** – All effort will be made to fulfil dietary requests, but they cannot be guaranteed. With the wide selection of menus and choice of dishes available at hotels, special dietary requests will be met where possible. If dietary requirements are strict, please check with your Travel Agent or APT concerning catering. You may have to carry a small supply of the necessary food (that does not require refrigeration).

### CAMP AND LODGE DINING

Home-style meals are served in open dining areas. Meals are plentiful, well-balanced and healthy. All included meals are clearly indicated on your itinerary.

**Breakfast** – consists of cereal, toast, jams, tea and coffee (sometimes a cooked breakfast).

**Lunch** – is usually prepared at the camp and taken with you as a picnic-style meal, with a variety of cold meats, salads, bread, tea and coffee. When it's not provided there will be scheduled stops during our travels where lunch can be purchased if desired.

**Dinner** – is usually a three-course affair with canapés, main course, dessert and tea or coffee. While dinners vary with each location, from barbecues to home-style cooking, they will always be healthy and well balanced.

At the Bungle Bungle Wilderness Lodge, the unique restaurant boasts a retractable roof so you can dine under the stars in fine weather.

## HOTEL DINING

**Breakfast** – is generally buffet-style comprising cereals, fruit juices and cooked dishes (eggs, bacon, sausages, etc.), toast, jams, tea and coffee.

**Lunch** – is sometimes provided as per camp and lodge dining (see your itinerary for details). When it's not included, lunch stops will be made allowing you to purchase a lunch that suits your appetite.

**Dinners** – are, at least, two-course meals with multiple-choice entrees (appetisers) and main courses, accompanied by salad or vegetables, and dessert. Occasionally dinners are à la carte and several are buffet-style, offering a wide selection of quality food. Meals are always accompanied by tea and coffee.

## ALCOHOL

Consumption of alcohol on board vehicles is strictly prohibited.

### Camps and Lodges

All dinners are accompanied by a complimentary glass of wine (for guests aged over 18).

The Bungle Bungle Wilderness Lodge is also licensed, which allows you to purchase pre or post dinner drinks. The remaining three camps and lodge are not licensed.

Should you wish to bring your own alcohol you are most welcome to do so. Alcohol can be purchased in Broome, Kununurra and Darwin. For environmental and safety reasons, please do not bring glass containers on your tour, aluminium and casks are acceptable.

### Restaurants

On an APT tour, all hotels in which you stay have fully licensed restaurants where you can purchase alcoholic beverages to enjoy with your meal.
