PERMANENT WILDERNESS LODGES & CAMPS

In partnership with the Aboriginal land owners, our lodges and camps are exclusive to KWA. Even the most remote of our accommodation offers you access to hot showers, mirrors, toilets and basins. At night relax around the campfire with your fellow travellers, while the camp is lit by low voltage lighting enabling you to move about safely and with ease.

As part of APT's commitment to care for our environment, all our lodges and camps are designed and run to leave a minimal ecological footprint. For this reason, cabins are not fitted with power points, and we ask that you not smoke in your rooms and ensure that cigarette butts are put in the rubbish bins.

CAMP HOSTS

All camps are permanently staffed with dedicated hosts, ensuring you enjoy delicious meals, friendly company and fantastic service.

FACILITIES IN YOUR TENTED CABINS

Gone are the days of setting up your own tent, sleeping on the ground, and temporary bathroom facilities. Your permanent tented cabins in our wilderness lodges and camps have twin beds, made up with fresh linen sheets and snug doonas, side tables and lighting to ensure your comfort. At our lodges, your cabin will also feature a front deck with camp chairs and private ensuite bathroom.

BUNGLE BUNGLE WILDERNESS LODGE

Set in the heart of World Heritage-listed Purnululu National Park, this award-winning lodge is your gateway to explore the Bungle Bungle ranges. Located on Bellburn Creek, the lodge is only a short distance from the unique Bungle Bungle domes, Cathedral Gorge, Mini Palms Gorge, Echidna Chasm and other awe inspiring features of the area. Surrounded by nature, you can experience the true wilderness in comfort and style.

UNGOLAN (MITCHELL FALLS) WILDERNESS LODGE

Nestled beside a waterhole on Camp Creek, the 24 tented cabins here are the only permanent accommodation on the remote Mitchell Plateau. A short distance from Mitchell Falls and set among Livistona palms and Eucalyptus trees, here you can explore the untouched wilderness or even swim in the waterhole.

IMINTJI WILDERNESS CAMP

Located near the Imintji Community Township, the camp is in Ngarinyin country. With stunning views of the King Leopold escarpment this shady camp provides a fantastic base for exploring the nearby magnificent Bell, Galvans and Barnett River gorges.

MARUNBABIDI WILDERNESS CAMP

This camp is set in tranquil bushland beside the upper King Edward River. Providing access to a region rich in Aboriginal rock art and abundant fauna, you'll have the opportunity to go swimming and fishing, and take in the sights and sounds of the native wildlife.

SAVINGS FOR SINGLE TRAVELLERS

If you're travelling alone and advised us when booking that you are happy to share a room with another traveller of the same gender, we will match you with another single traveller and you won't pay a single supplement. If we were unable to find you a room-mate, you will be provided with a single room of your own at no extra charge. Note that if you've chosen to share a room you cannot smoke in your room or cabin and understand that compatibility with your room-mate cannot be guaranteed.

If you requested your own room when booking, we will have arranged this, and notified you of the additional cost charged by the hotel. If you would like a room to yourself and have not advised us already, please contact us as soon as possible prior to the commencement of your tour (note that single rooms may not be available in some remote areas).

Accommodation – Hotels

ACCOMMODATED SAFARIS

Your accommodation is one of the most important elements of your adventure. Throughout your tour, you will stay in comfortable hotels in iconic destinations, experiencing the very best accommodation the Kimberley has to offer.

You will enjoy ample time to experience each spectacular region you visit. In the more remote locations, accommodation standards may vary, but we always provide the best accommodation available wherever we go touring.

Emma Gorge Resort, El Questro – Set on one million acres in the Kimberley, El Questro Wilderness Park boasts rugged gorges, waterfalls and a rich pioneering history. We stay in the comfortable tented cabins at the delightful Emma Gorge Resort.

All Seasons Kununurra – Situated at the gateway to the Kimberley, the All Seasons features modern facilities and comfortable rooms, and provides the perfect stop on your wilderness journey.

Gagudju Lodge Cooinda, Kakadu National Park – Offering stunning and unique accommodation, Gagudju Lodge Cooinda is set by Yellow Water Billabong in Kakadu. Relax in style with the convenience of a general store, restaurants and a swimming pool.

Fitzroy River Lodge, Fitzroy Crossing – Surrounded by natural bush grounds, Fitzroy River Lodge is located by Fitzroy River outside the Frontier settlement of Fitzroy Crossing. Here you can stay in safari cabins or motel rooms.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

If you have special requirements such as a preference for adjoining or neighbouring rooms, double beds, a ground floor room or a room near the main hotel facilities, please advise us as early as possible prior to commencing your tour so we can try to fulfil your request.

FACILITIES IN YOUR ROOM

Beds – Twin-bedded accommodation usually represents two single beds, though some hotels present twin share accommodation as one double bed and one single bed. A double room comprises one double bed designed for two people to share. Triple rooms comprise one double bed and one single or roll-away bed.

Shower/Bath/En Suite – All APT accommodation will feature private facilities (with the exception of some remote locations – refer to your itinerary). Your bathroom will always have a shower, toilet, hand-basin, towels and soap. Most have hair dryers.

Tea/Coffee Making – Your accommodation provides free tea and coffee making facilities in your room (with the exception of some remote locations – refer to your itinerary).

Mini Bars/Refrigerators – With the exception of some remote locations, most hotels used on APT tours feature a small refrigerator in the room. On many occasions, rooms feature a mini bar. This facility operates on an honesty system whereby you pay prior to departure for any drinks or snacks consumed. Please remember that these items can be expensive.

Television/Radio/Telephone – Most rooms will have a television, radio and telephone. However, in-room telephones can be expensive, and most hotels have public phones available. Again, in a few remote areas, these room facilities may not be available.

Laundry/Ironing Facilities – You will not find it necessary to bring a lot of luggage on tour as most of the hotels utilised will offer you free or coin-operated laundry facilities. Ironing facilities are also available either in the hotel laundry or an iron and ironing board will be supplied to your room on request.

No Luggage Worries – Porterage is taken care of by your Driver/Guide who will look after the efficient and safe handling of your luggage at all hotels, providing your luggage conforms to size and weight requirements.
